Rebuilding the Portishead to Bristol railway

I'm getting in touch to let you know about our latest stage of work to rebuild the Portishead to Bristol railway, including new stations at Pill and Portishead.

From **Monday 16 February until Monday 9 March**, we'll be cutting back vegetation in the Monmouth Road area of Pill. This is to create space for our site compound off Monmouth Road and to allow surveys of the land around the railway to take place. Fencing will also be put up around the compound.

All the work takes place on Network Rail land and will happen **during the day between 8am and 6pm**. The below map shows the areas where we'll be working.

Our site compound will be in use throughout the project. It will be converted into a car park for the new Pill station when the railway opens in 2028.

The nature of our work means some additional noise and traffic is unavoidable. We're aware we're working close to you and will try to minimise this as much as possible but we're sorry for any inconvenience.
